### **Lieutenant Governor Bryant to attend Ribbon Cutting at Adult Day Care**

**WEST COLUMBIA, S.C.** – On Saturday, June 24, 2017, Lieutenant Governor Kevin Bryant will attend a ribbon cutting for Hope Bridge at the Oaks in West Columbia. The ceremony is scheduled to begin at 2:00 p.m. at their [3532 Leaphart Road](#) location. Following the ribbon cutting, those in attendance will have an opportunity to tour the new center, and refreshments will be served.

Hope Bridge at the Oaks is an adult day care center that provides traditional day services along with health care and case management components. Adult day care is a viable community resource that provides much needed services to seniors, those living with Alzheimer's, and persons with disabilities. It also allows family members who care for a loved one the ability to have a break in their caregiving responsibilities during the day.

Hope Bridge at the Oaks currently has contracts with the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of Disabilities and Special Needs to provide services. The new location on Leaphart Road will have a specific focus on vulnerable adults with disabilities.

“We are delighted to have Lieutenant Governor Bryant join us for the opening of our fourth center in Lexington County,” said Barbara Wright, co-owner and operator of Hope Bridge at the Oaks, along with her husband, Randy. “Through the preventative services we offer, we’re making a difference by allowing individuals to remain in their homes and communities.”
